Purpose of the Community Trustees

The trustees will hold and manage the portion of settlement monies received from the Robinson Huron Treaty Annuities Claim. These funds will be held for the benefit Magnetawan First Nation, guided by the principles of the Seven Grandfather Teachings, and administered in accordance with the finalized Trust Deed.

Qualifications of Being a Trustee

To be eligible as an initial trustee, individuals must:

- Confirm they are not in a bankruptcy proceeding (an undischarged bankrupt);
- Have not been convicted of an indictable offense;
- Have not been convicted or accused of a summary offence including fraud, false pretenses or theft of property;
- Are of the age of 18 or older;
- And are a member of Magnetawan First Nation

Professional designations are not required, but candidates should demonstrate integrity, accountability, empathy, respect, teamwork, strong communication skills, critical thinking, problem-solving, and a commitment to the community and its vision, all guided by a strong ethical compass.

Structure of Community Trustee

The initial proposed composition of trustees will include:

- One member living on Magnetawan First Nation.

Trustee Terms and Rotation

The term of the Trustee will be as follows:

- One member living on Magnetawan First Nation will serve a 2-year term.
